OBJECTIVE AND KEY CHALLENGES

RESIST Eurocluster will provide financial support, also known as Financial Support to Third Parties (FSTP), to European small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) working in the Mobility, Transport and Automotive ecosystem, so they can implement **innovation projects on green and digital transition**, leading to economic success and resilience improvement in the face of future market changes and crisis.

FSTP is an instrument used by the European Commission to distribute public funds and generate opportunities for SMEs, start-ups and/or mid-cap companies, in the adoption or development of digital technologies.

THREE KEY CHALLENGES

1. Optimised digitalisation in my company through the incorporation of advanced technologies in the MTA

2. Provide innovative solutions to obtain greener production systems or products

3. Turning to renewable energy innovations in my production line



(*) Beneficiaries have to select one of the three above challenges as a topic for their innovation project proposal.







CONDITIONS OF THE OPEN CALL



Beneficiaries can apply for this Open Call as a consortium or individually:

For projects with a consortium of several eligible applicants, a Project Manager will be assigned and will mentor and guide the team throughout the whole project



Projects will last a maximum of 9 months

From February to November 2024 for the 2nd OpenCall cut-off



Partners in the project will accompany beneficiaries throughout project implementation



Beneficiaries must submit a mid-term report and a final project report following a specific monitoring document template



At least one Open Call project partner must participate in the Project Showcase event. The Showcase will take place in France on December 24/January 25











ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following **eligibility criteria** must be complied in order to get through the evaluation process:



European **SMEs** from the **Mobility-Transport-Automotive** (MTA) ecosystem. SMEs to be understood within the meaning of Recommendation 2003/361/EC in the version of 6 May 2003.



Beneficiary must come from Eurocluster partners' country or from **EU regions** different from the countries of individual Euroclusters' partners.



The **resilience check** must be completed. This document enables beneficiaries to audit their market situation, production, and processes towards potential risks and future market evolutions, and to set-up an action plan for mitigation of the main risks. This document will be sent once the beneficiary expressed its desire to apply for this call.



Beneficiaries applying in a consortium with other beneficiaries must come from at least **two different regions** and **maximum 3** to enhance collaboration and regional development. The projects must be led by an SME, start-up and/or midcap companies.



Beneficiaries can **re-apply to this cut-off** if the application for the 1st cut-off was not successful.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND FUNDING CONDITIONS

Up to 15 projects

will obtain financial support

Total budget available distributed among the two Open Call cut-offs

€ 800,000

- 20% of agreed lump sum at Innovation Project start (as pre-financing)
- 40% of agreed lump sum after evaluation of the mid-term project report and the mid-term financial report.
- 40% of agreed lump sum after evaluation of the final project report and the final financial report

Individual Projects

20,000 €/applicant*

Consortium Projects

30,000 €/applicant*



SMEs have the possibility of participating in all open calls to be launched within the framework of the RESIST initiative, but the maximum financial support possible for a single SME in all calls is limited to €60,000. It is the responsibility of the SME to check that the requested funding sums do not exceed this limit.








OPEN CALL 2ND CUTT-OFF TIMELINE

RESIST 2nd Open Call cut-off for innovative projects on green and digital transition will remain open from the **3rd of October** until the **12th of December 2023** at 12:00 CET (Central European Time).

Submission via the Clusters Submission Platform

Open call link


- The application form presenting the project concept, the Consortium if any, the planned activities and the expected results.
- The **Commitment Declaration**: to guarantee the veracity of the information provided.

Evaluation is conducted by to at least **three independent evaluators** that audit the proposal. Applications will be evaluated according to 5 criteria: *Innovation of*

■ The **resilience check** completed. It will be sent by Euroclusters' Project partners to the beneficiary(es) once they manifested their interest to apply for the Open Call Innovation.

the idea; Potential impact of the solution; Growth plan during and beyond the RESIST support period; Short-term implementation plan for the RESIST support period; Fit with RESIST priorities.
